

Include a page number on each page in the upper right. Be sure to use the page number feature so the page number will change.

Name of Your Paper (in Bold)

Bold and center your descriptive title. Have one additional line space before your name, Charter College, the Instructor's name, the Class name, and the Due Date.

The second page should have your title centered and bolded at the top with a page number in the right of the header.

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Name of your Paper (in Bold)

Start your paper here with a clear introduction to your topic. Under the 7th edition of APA formatting doesn't require student papers to have an abstract, it does indicate that you should include one if requested. Please review your instructor requirements carefully.
